

Online registration for WIL, WBL announced

11 April 2016 - The Department has announced that it has launched an application where students and employers can register online to access or offer work integrated learning (WIL) or workplace based learning (WBL) opportunities.

The application will help students in the post-school education and training sector in South Africa who are required to gain mandatory experience with employers in order to acquire their desired qualification. This experience allows students to integrate the theory and practice.

In the past, students have faced challenges in securing WIL and WBL opportunities.

Employers and industry can also use the online registration facility, developed by the Department, to register and indicate what WIL/WBL opportunities they are able to offer.
