DEPUTY MINISTER BUTI MANAMELA WILL LAUNCH THE THABO MOFUTSANYANA DISTRICT MUNICIPALITY PROJECT

The Deputy Minister of Higher Education and Training, Buti Manamela will launch the Thabo Mofutsanyana District Municipality Project aimed at addressing the skills shortage, unemployment and poverty within the Thabo Mofutsanyana District and the local municipalities on Thursday, 13 December 2018.

The launch of this project is an outcome of the partnership between the Thabo Mofutsanyana District and the Construction Education and Training Authority (CETA), signed in 2016. CETA initiates skills projects and learnerships aimed at improving and developing South Africa's human resources, including a construction workforce whose skills are recognised and valued in terms of the National Qualification Frameworks (NQF).

Approximately 3 050 learners will benefit from this project through training in the following trades: Plumbing, Electrical, Carpentry, Tiling, Bricklaying, Painting, Building and Civil Construction, Supervision of Construction Process, Health and Safety and Construction contracting.
