Principles

1. Physical meetings should be held with the academic staff of CET Colleges because of the enormity and sensitivity of the issues.
2. A total of minimum 10% of staff to attend the meetings. These should be comprised of DHET Officials (Head Office and Regions), GPSSBC FETCBU Task Team members; CET College management; CLC managers/ leaders, and lecturers nominated/ delegated by the college lecturers. All covid-19 protocols to be observed.
3. The Meetings must be led by the Deputy Director-General for Corporate Services or the Deputy-Director-General for Community Education and Training (one meeting led by one DDG);
4. Regional Managers and Regional Directors must be present in all meetings and provide support to CET college Principals and their management
5. CET College Principals must determine the venue(s) for engagements, provide transport and catering for College delegates.
6. Due to the urgency of the meetings, lecturers should be encouraged to attend even during college closure periods where feasible. The College will provide transport.
